### MobileGov piloted by the City of Cannes

(MobileGov) The IST project MobileGov is moving further ahead with its software security solution for detecting changes to hardware in digital systems. The city of Cannes in France has signed a strategic partnership with the company to perform the first pilot testing of the Mobilegov technology. "This system allows us to better respond to our responsibility to protect the significant data that a municipality must manage," says Didier Vescovi, Director of the Information and telecommunications unit of the city of Cannes. The project is the first to restrain the usage of external computer devices so that it can only run on a given computer system, explains Michel Frenkiel. It also extends the security to confidential material on, for instance, a USB key which becomes unusable on another computer, which should make it less attractive for thieves, according to Mr Frenkiel.
