THE SOPHIA ANTIPOLIS AGGLOMERATION COMMUNITY SECURES ITS EXTRANET WITH THE DIGITAL DNA.

Sophia Antipolis, July 6th, 2010 – the CASA (Sophia Antipolis Agglomeration Community) now secures the accesses of hundreds of councillors to its extranet with the Digital DNA technology.

The mayors of 19 municipalities, their deputies and alternates, totaling up to a hundred persons of the Agglomeration Community, were so far exchanging sensitive data with the illusory protection of a single password. A lack of discretion or a spyware would have been sufficient to divert the results of their work, as it occurred for two Deputies last March.

Jean Leonetti, Antibes-Juan les Pins Deputy-Mayor and President of the CASA, wished for a simple answer to this risk. The CASA found it with a company, settled in the technological area of Sophia-Antipolis, offering an innovative and useful service.

The Digital DNA technology by Mobilegov, protected by international patents, is able to uniquely identify any IT equipment. Hence, a user can authenticate with his own USB key, computer or smartphone, used either in replacement of or in addition to the password.

To make the user experience easier, the CASA has chosen to no longer use passwords and to strengthen the symbolic message of the operation, it has chosen a USB key as the new Extranet Sesame.

Installing the Digital DNA on the CASA website has only required an update of the Microsoft Sharepoint 2010 settings. The Digital DNA now secures accesses to online documents and provides better traceability, which will enable to expand the uses of the Extranet.

The official launch took place last Monday, July 5th, in Antibes in the presence of the regional press.

Each councillor was given a USB key, engraved with his name, allowing him to instantly connect to his online space.

The signing of this contract confirms the validity of Mobilegov's business model: providing the numerous communities that are unsatisfied with competing solutions that are too heavy and too expensive, an access control solution that is simple to install, respectful of privacy, easy to understand and to use. The security level is scalable and can go up to strong authentication.

This contract encourages Mobilegov to continue its marketing effort on public administrations, for whom the Internet is a challenge but also a threat.
